In view of the fact that universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the machinery and are much less vulnerable to destruction. These buckets are likewise 50% deeper as opposed to the quick-tach bucket models. This additional space makes them perfect for carrying irregular shaped loads like backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles and broken up concrete.
